HORSE THEMED BOOKS ON EVERY SHELF

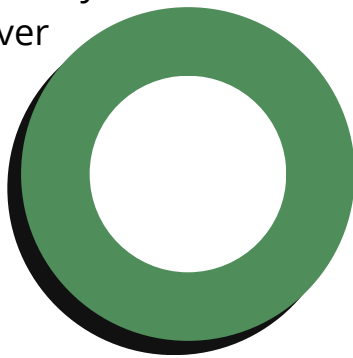

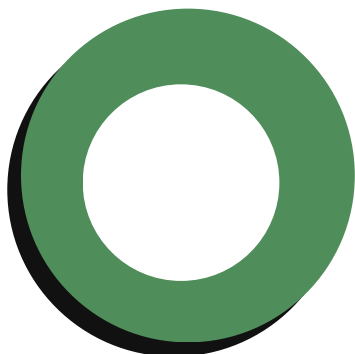
THEY HAVE A SINCERE DESIRE TO WORK WITH HORSES
